In January, Homer will vote on the sale of treated water and sewer services to Sunrise Coal's proposed mine.

Selling even small quantities of treated water and sewer would help the coal mine to establish itself. This is a concern because the large scale withdrawal of water for washing coal, plus mine discharges, threaten local water resources and the health of the Salt Fork river.

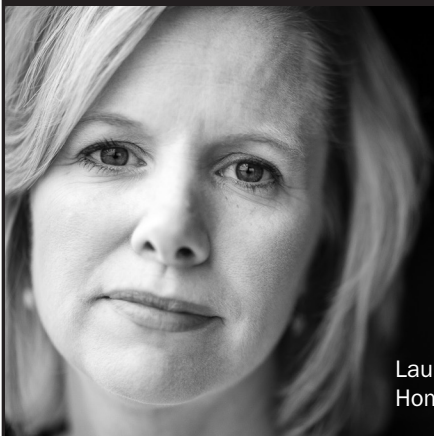
Please plan to attend and tell your Village Board members to **vote no** on any water sale to the proposed coal mine.

No Water for Coal Mine

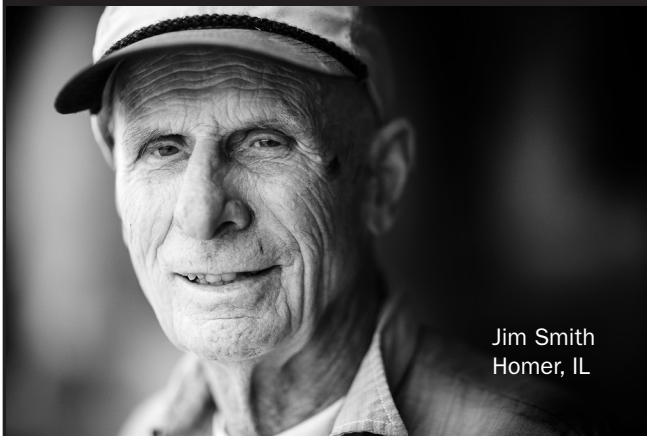
ACT NOW: Please contact your Village Board members and ask them to **vote “no”** on any water or sewer sales to the proposed coal mine.
